Chief Master Sergeant Kevin Miner is the Superintendent, 422d Communications Squadron, Royal Air Force Croughton, United Kingdom. He serves as the Senior Enlisted Advisor to the Commander for 160 Airmen in nine diverse Air Force Specialties. He leads teams in the operations and maintenance of a Standardized Tactical Entry Point satellite terminal, a cyber-transport facility, and a tri-base local area network in support of the National Command Authority, Combatant Commanders, the DOD, and the DOS. He serves as the base liaison to the MAJCOM Functional and AF Career Field Managers on all enlisted cyberspace support personnel issues including training and resource management. He advises the commander on morale, strategic management, operations, and, quality of life of military and civilian members.

Chief Miner is a native of Grand Rapids, Michigan. He enlisted in the Air Force in July 1995 and attended technical training at Keesler AFB, Mississippi to become a Precision Measurement Lab Apprentice. In May 2001, he cross-trained into the Communications-Computer Systems Operations and later Cyber Operations career field. He has served in a wide array of positions throughout his career including Technical Training Instructor, FOA staff, MAJCOM staff, and COCOM staff. Additionally, he deployed to Baghdad, Iraq in 2010 in support of OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM. Before assuming his current position, he served as the AFOSI Field Support Squadron Superintendent providing personnel, logistics readiness, and communications support to over 3,200 AFOSI Special Agents and Professional Staff at over 264 geographically separated units throughout the world. He arrived at his current assignment in May 2019.
